



BOARDING HOUSE RULES – 2017

- **NO** tuck, money or medicine is to be kept in the bedrooms. Hand in to the house Mom (Mrs Rayner) with note of instructions.
- **Only** boarders are allowed in the boarding house. Day pupils are not allowed in the boarding house.
- Boarders are not allowed in the boarding house between 7:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. without permission from the house Mom.
- **No boarder is allowed into the bedroom of any other boarder at any time or for any reason.**
- No running in the passages or on the steps.
- Rooms are to be kept clean and tidy:
 - Beds made
 - Towels hung up
 - Dirty laundry put into laundry bags
 - Clean clothes and shoes are to be neatly stored in cupboards.
- Pupils must be properly dressed for meals:
Breakfast: School uniform
Lunch: School uniform
Supper: Suitable civvies
Shoes must be worn to all meals.
Dressing Gowns and Slippers must be worn after bathing.
- Laundry Bags available from Mrs Rayner for R 50.00 each.
- Pupils must respect school property and other people's possessions.
- These areas are out of bounds for boarders:
 - The kitchen and staff room.
 - The swimming pool – unless supervised by a staff member.
 - The front area of the school (facing the road) is strictly out of bounds.
 - Classrooms.

Children are free to play on the countryside of the boarding house building, within the fenced area.

- **Cell phones** are forbidden. Boarders may receive or make phone calls only at these times:
